In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 15 of the Mahrashtra Felling of Trees (Regulation) Act, 1964 (Mah. XXXIV of 1964), the Government of Maharashtra hereby makes like following rules, the same having been previously published as required by sub-section (1) of the said section 15, namely:—

1. Short title.—T a rules may be called the Maharashtra Felling of Trees

- Definitions.—In these rules, unless the context otherwise requires.—

  (a) "Act" means the Maharashtra Felling of Trees (Regulation) Act, 1961;

  (b) "Form" means a form appended to these rules;

  (c) "Section" means a section of the Act. 3. Application for permission under 1 section 3(1A)].—(1) Any person seeking permission of the Revenue Officer under 1 sub-section (1A) of section 3 to fell any tree or trees shall make an application in Form I. The application shall be presented either in person or be sent by post.
- (2) On receipt of the application, the Revenue Officer shall acknowledge its receipt the application is complete in all respects. If the application is incomplete, he shall immediately return the application to the applicant pointing out to him the after completing it in all respects.
- 4. Grant of permission.—(1) On receipt of an application under rule 3, the Revenue Officer shall, after holding such inquiry as he deems fit, accertain whether the applicant has any right otherwise to fell the the tree of trees to be selled in the land is of are of his ownership; and if the land is not of his ownership, whether the applicant has any right otherwise to fell the

  (3) If the Revenue Officer is satisfied that the applicant has a right to fell the tree or trees applied for, and the felling of the tree or trees is applied for any of the reasons specified in the proviso to [sub-section (1B) of section 3] or will not defeat the object of the Act, he shall grant the permission to fell the tree or trees applied for in Form II the principle of the specified in writing for doing so.
- 5. Condition of permission.—Every person to whom a permission is granted under rule 4 shall be liable to pay damages for any injury caused to the property of any person as a result of the felling of a tree or trees in pursuance of the permission.
