No WLP 10-07/CR 255/F-1--Whereas, it appears to Government of Maharashtra that the area described in the schedule (hereafter referred as the "said area") comprised within East Nashik Forest Division of Nashik District for reasons of its ecological, faunal, floral, significance, needs to be constituted as a "Conservation Reserve" for the purpose of protecting, propagating and developing wildlife therein and its environment.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 36-A of the Wildlife (protection) Act, 1972 Amendment Act, 2002 the Government of Maharashtra hereby :-

- 2) Declares the said area as a "Conservation Reserve" to be known as Bhorkada (Borgad) "Conservation Reserve" on and from the 5th day of March 2008



NOTIFICATION

WILD LIFE (PROTECTION) ACT, 1972.

No.WLP-2012/C.R. 272/F-1.—Whereas, it appears to Government of Maharashtra after having consultation with local communities that the area owned by Government described in schedule (hereinafter referred to as the “said area”) comprised within Sironcha Forest Division of Gadchiroli District being adjacent to Indrawati National Park in Chhatishgarh and for reasons of its ecological, faunal and floral significance, needs to be constituted as a “Conservation Reserve” for the purpose of protecting Wild Buffalo’s, Landscape flora and fauna therein and their habitat.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 36-A of the Wild Life (protection) Act, 1972 Amendment Act, 2002 the Government of Maharashtra hereby :—

(1) Specifies the limits of the said area set out as below.

(2) Declares the said area as a “Conservation Reserve” to be known as “Kolamarka Conservation Reserve” on and from the day of 8th January 2013.
